1. Login to the Portal, select your patient and click on the 'View' tab
2. Select the report you want to see in text view

**Not every type of charting result will display with the CM Doc View module. In particular, lab and radiology results and the ED Record will NOT display in CM Doc View. Reports like the *Anticoag Review* or the *Pulmonology Review* that contain a class of pertinent lab results will display all of the charting, but none of the lab results. You can either continue to use the HED Review module on the 'Review' tab for these Reports or simply review the lab results separately.

Advantages of the new CM Doc View Module

The current HED Review module only allows you to see documentation in a truncated format. You have to click on each comment individually to open the comment. The new CM Doc View Module will allow you to see the comments without having to click on each comment individually.
